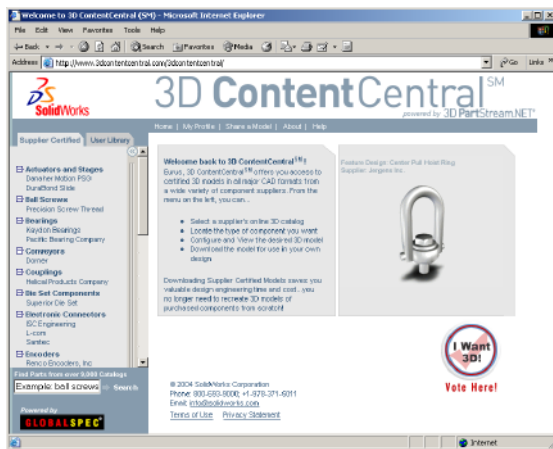

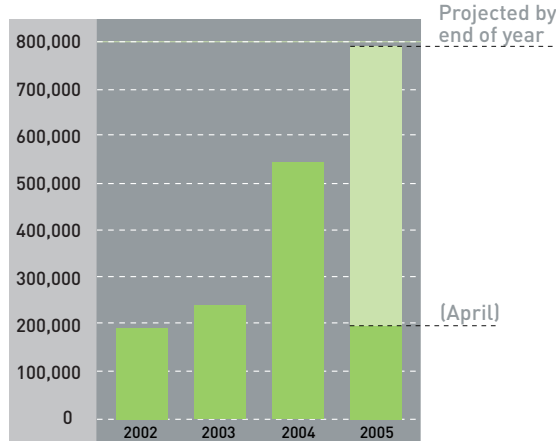

The exploding usage of 3D ContentCentral

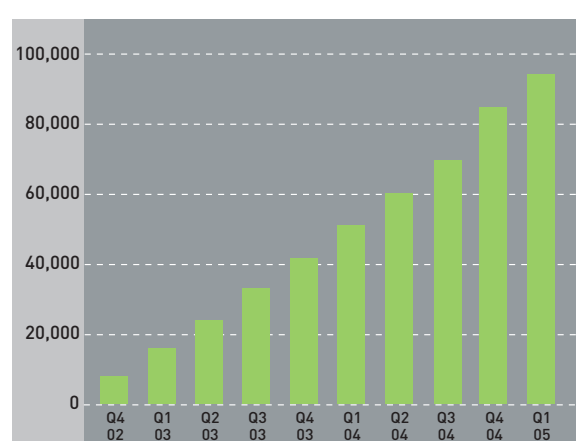

3D CONTENTCENTRAL - CUMULATIVE USER INTERACTIONS PER YEAR

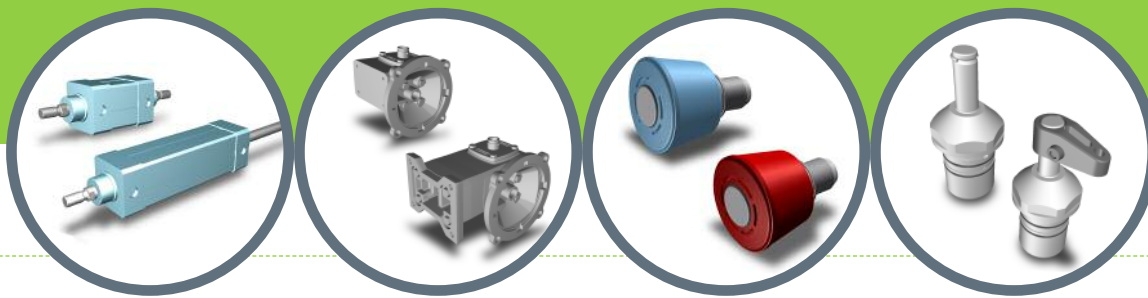

3D CONTENTCENTRAL - CUMULATIVE REGISTERED USERS PER MONTH

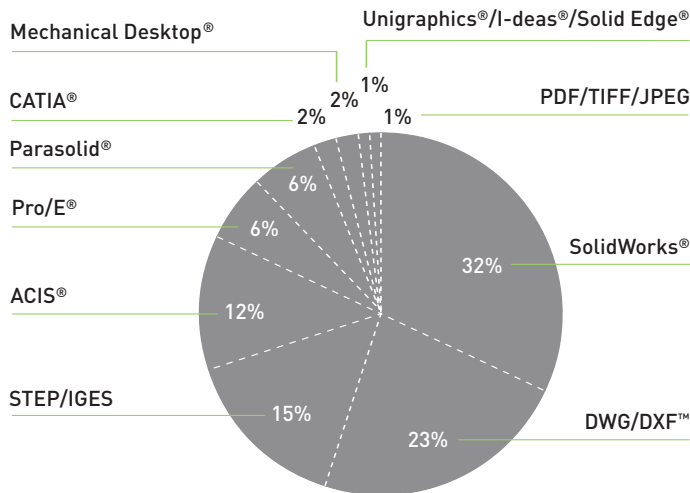


The number of users signing up for 3D ContentCentral has grown rapidly since it was first introduced in 2002.

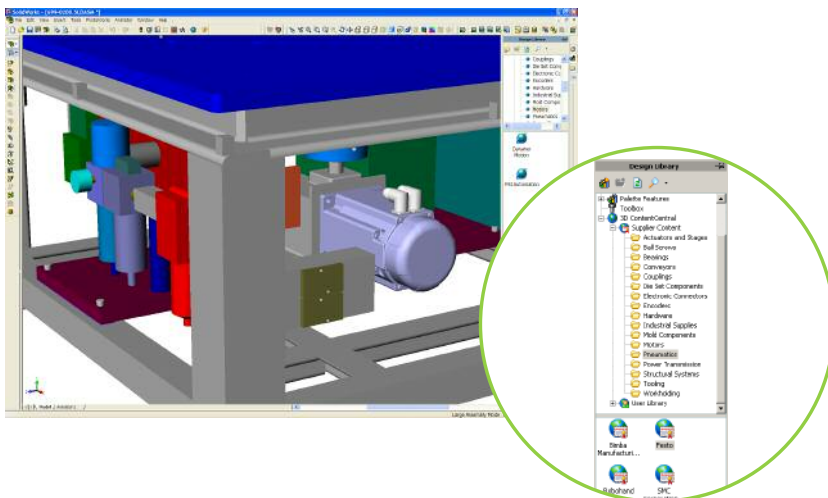
3D CONTENTCENTRAL - DOWNLOADS BY FILE

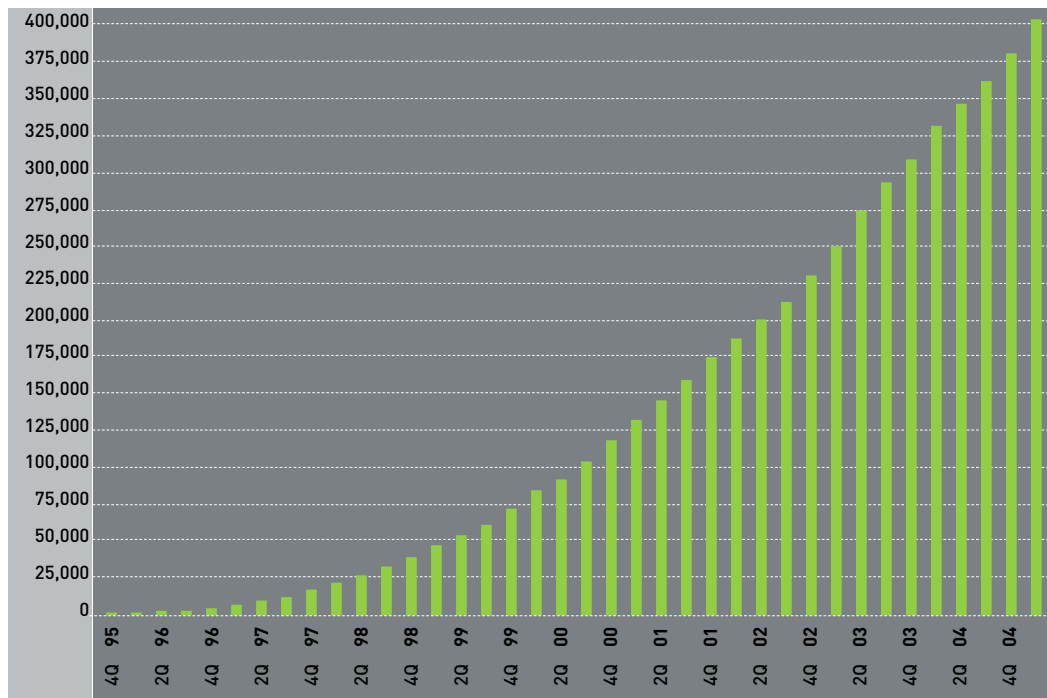

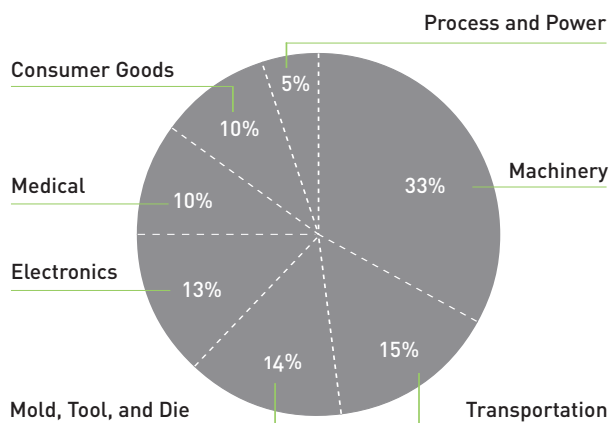
GROWTH OF SOLIDWORKS USER BASE



The population of SolidWorks users has grown steadily since the software was first introduced.

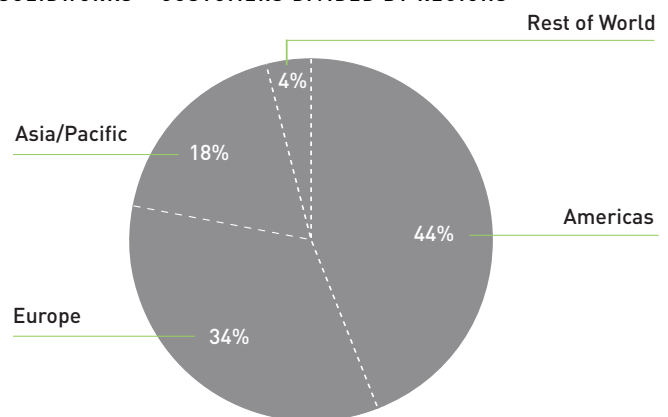

SOLIDWORKS - CUSTOMERS BY INDUSTRY



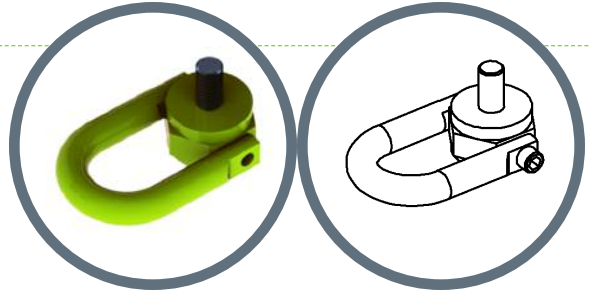
Approximately 33% of SolidWorks users design machinery, and the rest are spread across a variety of industries.
